


• Agency mission:

• Regulation and oversight of pari-mutuel wagering







Oregon Racing Commission Revenue Sources



Revenue = 100% Other Funds

- Fees charged to racing participants and companies licensed to do business in Oregon
- Cash value of unclaimed winning tickets at Portland Meadows
- Fines assessed against racing industry participants
- Taxes on wagers placed at Portland Meadows and five summer fair race meets

60% of the agency's revenue comes from Advanced Deposit Wagering taxes, of which onethird goes to the General Fund and the rest supports the racing industry
