## TUITION EQUITY WILL:

- Add tuition dollars to Ore. public universities
- Help guarantee that every Oregonian has fair access to quality, affordable higher ed
- Capitalize on Ore. investment in all K-12 students
- Boost the education level of Ore. workforce
- Attract businesses/jobs for a highly skilled workforce
- Bring in more tax dollars for the general fund

## TUITION EQUITY WON'T:

- Cost the state anything
- Take away out-of-state tuition dollars from public higher ed
- Prevent U.S. citizens from attending Ore. schools
- Give special treatment to college applicants
- Violate federal law
- Provide access to financial aid for undocumented students

## TUITION EQUITY REQUIRES:

- Students have attended an Ore. high school for at least three years
- Students have graduated from an Ore. high school
- Students have been admitted to an Oregon University System institution
- Students are working towards residency
