

**FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION**

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**Measure Description:**

Appropriates moneys to Oregon Health Authority for Primary Care Services Program.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU)

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting this measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill establishes the primary care provider loan repayment program for the purpose of assisting primary care providers who have committed to serving in rural or medically underserved areas of the state. The bill also establishes the Primary Care Provider Loan Repayment Fund, and appropriates \$4 million General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013 to be used to implement and operate the program.

The bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Oregon Health Authority and the Office of Rural Health in the Oregon Health Sciences University. The full impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
