### **Measure Description:**

Authorizes Department of Corrections to make grants to counties for provision of reentry support and services to certain offenders under 19 years of age.

# **Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Corrections, Oregon Youth Authority (OYA), Counties

**Summary of Expenditure Impact:** See Analysis

#### **Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

### **Analysis:**

The measure authorizes the Department of Corrections to make grants to counties for the provision of reentry support and services, including transitional housing, to certain offenders under 19 years of age. The measure stipulates that the grants shall be made from funds appropriated to the Department for the purposes defined in the measure.

The fiscal impact is indeterminate. The grant program is subject to the availability of funding. The availability and amount of funds potentially appropriated by the Legislature for the grant program is unknown. Administration of the program will vary depending on the level of funds available and the demand for the grants.
