**Measure Description:**

Permits small woodland owner to register vehicle as farm vehicle if woodland and vehicle meet certain requirements.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:** This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Business and Transportation Committee to the Senate Finance and Revenue Committee. The bill permits small woodland owners to register a vehicle as a farm vehicle under certain circumstances. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Finance and Revenue Committee.
