Measure Description:

Removes requirement that grant to purchase Oregon food products and to fund certain educational activities be allocated in specified percentage.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill removes the requirement to purchase Oregon food products and fund certain educational activities to be allocated in a specified percentage and appropriates \$5,000,000 General Fund for the grant program in ORS 336.431. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means
