## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Fair Dismissal Appeals Board hears appeals from teachers and administrators who have been dismissed from employment in one of Oregon's 197 school districts. If a school district dismisses a teacher or does not renew the contract of a teacher or administrator, the teacher or administrator can appeal to the Fair Dismissal Appeals Board. The Board received 12 appeals in both 2011 and 2012. A hearing can last between one and five days.
