Measure Description:

Requires persons operating certain high-mileage motor vehicles to pay per-mile road usage charge or flat annual road usage charge.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Transportation and Economic Development to the House Committee on Revenue and then the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill would require certain cars under certain circumstances to pay a per-mile or road usage fee. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means
