Measure Description: Extends the sunset date for the tax credit for contributions of computer or scientific equipment from January 1, 2014 to January 1, 2020. Maintains the requirement that contributions must be made to educational organizations in Oregon.

Revenue Impact: A revenue loss of less than \$50,000 per year.

Impact Explanation: Typically, fewer than five corporations claim this tax credit each year. From tax years 2005 through 2010, corporations claimed an average total of \$220,000 in tax credits but were only able to reduce their liability by an average of \$30,000 annually.
