**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Memorializes community activist and longest-serving Portland Community College board member Harold Williams, 1943 – 2012.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Contributions of Harold Williams to Portland Community College, the community and the State

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** According to a review of Mr. Williams’ accomplishments in [The Oregonian on July 12, 2012](#), “After decades of working for the state on labor and civil rights issues, Williams joined the PCC board in 1990 as representative for North Portland and portions of Columbia County. In more than 20 years on the board, he advocated for the college to expand to North Portland and other areas where low-income people predominantly lived. He led mentorship programs, connecting the college to Jefferson students. And Williams pushed for a college policy that would ensure college construction contracts would meet minority-contracting goals.”
