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**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Increases fee paid by defendant to agency performing diagnostic assessment from \$90 to \$275 for possession of marijuana diversion agreements. Declares emergency, effective upon passage.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Fee has not increased in 23 years; it is no longer in line with operation costs

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** House Bill 2052 updates ORS 135.921 to require payment of diagnostic fees consistent with the increased cost of services provided. This fee has not been increased since 1990.
