WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows the Oregon Department of Corrections (DOC) to continue to contract with other public entities to send Oregon inmates to out of state corrections facilities through January 2, 2018.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Transit costs
- Last sent inmates out of state for prison crowding in 1995
- Standards of confinement in other states
- Cannot send to private prisons

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Currently the DOC has the statutory authority to contract with out-of-state public entities. The DOC does so when faced with prison overcrowding. This statutory authority sunsets on January 2, 2014.
