**Measure Description:**

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to the Recovery Association Project of Oregon for establishment and maintenance of a revolving loan fund to aid in the development of housing for veterans or victims of domestic violence

The bill appropriates General Fund monies to the Department of Administrative Services for distribution to the Recovery Association Project of Oregon (RAP) for the establishment and maintenance of a revolving loan fund to aid in the development of housing for veterans or victims of domestic violence. The bill does not contain a mechanism for the repayment of these funds or requirements for the administration of the revolving loan fund.
