WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Establishes Oregon Code of Military Justice governing state militia.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Completes migration of state statute to regulatory code

- One substantive change narrowing statute of limitations in conformity with Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ)
- Annual update of UCMJ and inefficiency making corresponding changes in state statute
- Improved efficiency upon conclusion of migration from statute to code

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Senate Bill 32 marks the completion of a transition that began in 2005, to organize state laws governing the military into a comprehensive body of regulatory code – the Oregon Code of Military Justice – aligned with the Uniform Code of Military Justice at the federal level.
