**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Establishes Oregon Code of Military Justice governing state militia.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Completes migration of state statute to regulatory code
- One substantive change narrowing statute of limitations in conformity with Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ)
- Annual update of UCMJ and inefficiency making corresponding changes in state statute
- Improved efficiency upon conclusion of migration from statute to code

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Senate Bill 32 marks the completion of a transition that began in 2005, to organize state laws governing the military into a comprehensive body of regulatory code – the Oregon Code of Military Justice – aligned with the Uniform Code of Military Justice at the federal level.
