WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires person engaged in trade or business that makes payment for construction services to report to payee and Department of Revenue. Provides for penalties for failure to make required report. Takes effect 91 days after sine die.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Appropriate committee to hear the measure

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The committee believes the question of whether a business purchasing construction services should report payments to the service provider and to the Department of Revenue is one that is more aptly addressed by the House Revenue Committee.
