**Measure Description:** Extends the sunset date for the political contributions tax credit from January 1, 2014 to January 1, 2020.

**Impact Explanation:** Over the past four years, an average of nearly 107,000 taxpayers have claimed this tax credit annually. In total, these taxpayers have claimed an average of \$7.3 million each year and have reduced their taxes by \$6.7 million each year. The amount claimed and used follows the political cycle with greater usage in even years and the greatest usage in years of a presidential election. In addition to its cyclical nature, there has been mild growth over time. The estimated impact here assumes a continuation of this mild growth while accounting for the political cycle. For example, the greater estimated impact in 2015-17 is driven by the presidential election year of 2016.
