Measure Description: Creates an income and corporate excise tax credit for contributions made to a qualifying organization. Defines a qualifying organization as an entity that is tax exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is organized for the purpose of providing funding for legal services provided through the Legal Services Program. Sets the credit at 50 percent of the contribution made and allows the credit in addition to any charitable deduction taken by the taxpayer. The tax credit is effective for tax years 2014 through 2019.
