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Measure Description:

Allows state agency to establish voluntary contribution programs that allow persons to make voluntary contributions for projects identified by agency as worthy of funding, and of interest to public, but for which no or inadequate funding sources exist.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Statewide

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Consumer Protection and Government Efficiency to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill allows for the establishment of voluntary contribution programs that allow the general public to make contributions for projects identified by an agency as worthy of funding.
