Measure Description:

Establishes Scholars for a Healthy Oregon Initiative to provide free tuition and fees for certain students in health care disciplines in exchange for student commitment to work in underrepresented locations after graduation.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill establishes the Scholars for a Healthy Oregon Initiative and appropriates \$4.9 million from the General Fund. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
