Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys to Department of Human Services to provide mental health and addiction services to seniors and persons with disabilities.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Human Services (DHS), Oregon Health Authority

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting this measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The bill appropriates an unspecified amount out of the General Fund to the Department of Human Services for the 2013-15 biennium for mental health and addiction services for seniors and persons with disabilities. This bill is expected to have a fiscal impact on the Addictions and Mental Health Services division of the Oregon Health Authority, and on the Aging and People with Disabilities program within the Department of Human Services. The full impact of this bill is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
