Measure Description:

Extends period of applicability of emergency communications tax.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Revenue, Oregon State Police, Oregon Military Department, Local Governments

Summary of Expenditure Impact: See Analysis

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure extends the applicability of the emergency communications tax under ORS 403.200 to January 1, 2022. Currently the tax would sunset January 1, 2014.

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Veterans Services and Emergency Preparedness to the House Revenue Committee. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Revenue Committee.
