WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Adopts rules for the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Rules adopted followed the Administrative Procedures Act
- Opportunity for public comment at agency rulemaking

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission's (CJC) purpose is to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of state and local criminal justice systems by providing a centralized and impartial forum for statewide policy development and planning. Unlike other agencies, the CJC administrative rules must be adopted by the legislature. ORS 137.667(4) states that rules adopted by the CJC are not in effect unless approved by the next legislative session. SB 638 adopts a new administrative rule, OAR 213-018-0037 Felony Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants (ORS 813.010(5) and chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2011), and makes amendments to existing rules on sentencing, probation and the crime seriousness scale.
