Measure Description:

Requires State Board of Education to adopt rules requiring provision of fluoride rinse to certain students and children after certain meals.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Early Learning Council, School Districts, Department of Education

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill would require the Department of Education to require provision of a fluoride rinse to certain students after certain meals. School Districts would be required to provide this service to the affected students during the course of a school day. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means
