Measure Description:

Directs Office of Secretary of State to conduct study regarding fees imposed on small businesses by local and state agencies and to implement program to assist small businesses in obtaining waivers or deferrals of fees.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Secretary of State

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Business and Labor to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill requires the Secretary of State to conduct a study and use the results of the study to form an ongoing program. The scope and cost of the program can only be determined by the outcome of the study. The agency anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means
