Measure Description:

Requires public school students seven years of age or younger who are beginning educational program to have vision screening.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), School Districts, Department of Education, Early Learning Council, Education Service Districts (ESD)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill requires public school students of a certain age to have vision screening. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill. The amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
