**Measure Description:** Revises the method of calculating the Transportation Grant for purposes of distributing the State School Fund. Allows school districts to determine distances beyond which school districts will provide transportation for their students. Allows the Oregon Department of Education to expend up to \$3 million per biennium out of the State School Fund, to assist school districts in complying with core teaching standards requirements. Takes effect on July 1, 2013.

**Revenue Impact (in \$Millions):** This bill does not change the total formula revenue available for distribution to school districts and education service districts. It has a subsequent referral to the Senate Finance and Revenue Committee. Detailed analysis will be done when the bill is in that committee.
