Measure Description:

Establishes requirements for health insurance coverage of autism spectrum disorders.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Department of Human Services (DHS)

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.
