WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Increases the amount of balance held in the Criminal Justice Revolving Account from \$750,000 to \$2,500,000. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Provisions of the measure

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Funds resulting from attorney fees, settlements or civil penalties in racketeering cases brought by the Oregon Department of Justice are held in the Criminal Justice Revolving Account. The account amount has been capped at \$750,000 since 1983. Funds over the capped amount are deposited in the general fund.
