Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys to Department of Justice for Restitution Collection Pilot Program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Justice, Judicial Department

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure extends the sunset on the Restitution Collection Pilot Program Fund to July 1, 2016. Previously the program was to sunset July 1, 2014. The measure adds compensatory fine collections to the pilot program and extends the sunset on reporting requirements for the Department of Justice and Judicial Department on the status of the pilot program to February 2, 2015.

The measure appropriates \$2,295,370 General Fund to the Department of Justice for the 2013-2015 biennium to be deposited in the Restitution Collection Pilot Program Fund. The unobligated moneys revert to the General Fund July 1, 2016.
