Measure Description: Allows a virtual public charter school to receive funding from the General Fund, for providing supplemental online courses to certain students enrolled in public schools in Oregon. Takes effect on July 1, 2013.

Revenue Impact: This bill does not change the amount of total formula revenue available for distribution to school districts and education service districts.

Impact Explanation: This bill allows the Oregon Department of Education to distribute up to \$1.5 million in the 2013-14 school year, and up to \$3.75 million in the 2014-15 school year, in funding virtual public charter schools that provide supplemental online courses defined in the bill. Since this additional funding comes from the General Fund, this bill has no implication on the State School Fund distribution.
