**Measure Description:**

Directs Public Defense Services Commission to adopt policies and negotiate contracts that provide for compensation of appointed counsel at rate equivalent to assistant or deputy district attorney of comparable experience practicing within same county as appointed counsel.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Public Defense Services Commission

**Summary of Expenditure Impact:** See Analysis

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:**

The measure directs the Public Defense Services Commission to adopt policies and negotiate contracts that provide compensation of appointed counsel at a rate equivalent to an assistant or deputy district attorney of comparable experience practicing within the same county as the appointed counsel's primary practice.
