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**Measure Description:**

Allows student with disability to earn credit at community college or public university as part of transition services.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Education Service Districts (ESD), School Districts, Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Department of Education, Oregon University System (OUS)

**Summary of Expenditure Impact:**

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:** This bill would allow students with a disability to earn credit from a community college for transition services.

The agencies affected do not anticipate more than a minimal fiscal impact, however community colleges could see a fiscal impact due to having to insure that transition activities match existing courses or the community colleges may have to develop a course, or courses, that would fit with transition activities. This cost would be borne by the community colleges.
