**Measure Description:**

Makes legislative findings regarding merits of state agency administration and enforcement of state building code for capital construction projects receiving state-supplied funding.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Cities, Counties

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Consumer Protection and Government Efficiency to the House Rules Committee.
