**WHAT THE BILL DOES:** Makes technical adjustments to local budget law statutes.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Links to HB 2425 from 2011 session.
- No substantive change in local budget law.
- Most changes resulting from re-organizing statute, adding references and inserting conforming language.

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:** No Amendments

**BACKGROUND:** In 2011 the Legislature approved HB 2425. HB 2425 was a comprehensive rewrite of local budget law, the first since 1963. SB 817 is a follow-up to HB 2425, making some corrections and updating sections that were missed. Local budget law provides the framework in which counties, cities, education districts and special districts develop and execute their budgets.
