WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Authorizes owner of lot in planned community or unit in condominium to install and use electric vehicle charging station. Clarifies non-commercial personal use of charging station. Permits recovery of reasonable costs of review, permitting, installation and use of charging station.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Electric Highway
- Electric vehicle charging connectors
- California legislation model

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Clarifies noncommercial personal use of charging station and adds provisions for recovery of reasonable costs of review, permitting, and installation and use of charging station.

BACKGROUND: Electric vehicle charging stations provide electric energy to charge motor vehicles. Due to federally funded projects, numerous charging stations have been installed in public places, businesses and residences throughout Oregon. In 2012, the Oregon Department of Transportation and the state Department of Energy announced the opening of charging stations along Interstate 5 of the Willamette Valley. House Bill 3301 A authorizes the owner of a lot in a planned community of a unit in a condominium to install and use an electric vehicle charging station.
