**Measure Description:**

Allows brewery-public house licensee or winery licensee to operate mobile premises for purpose of dispensing securely covered containers of alcoholic beverages from parked premises.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC)

**Summary of Expenditure Impact:**

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:**

The Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) generally believes that it will be able to implement the provisions of the measure using existing resources and therefore the bill is presumed to have a minimal fiscal impact on the agency. However, the OLCC also notes that the mobile nature of the units may involve some unforeseeable issues with compliance resulting in the possible need for additional resources in the future.
