Measure Description:

Directs Superintendent of Public Instruction to form advisory committee for purpose of identifying incentives to encourage school districts to sponsor public charter school that specializes in serving economically impoverished communities.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, School Districts

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill Directs Superintendent of Public Instruction to form advisory committee for purpose of identifying incentives to encourage school district to sponsor public charter that specializes in serving economically impoverished communities and directs the Department of Education to submit a report to the Legislative Assembly on implementation of the findings of the advisory committee. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
