Measure Description:

Establishes office of State Chief Information Officer for purpose of directing policy and coordinating state government and state agencies in planning for, acquiring, installing and using telecommunications and information technology.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services (DAS)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Consumer Protection and Government Efficiency to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill creates a state agency, the Office of State Chief Information Officer, by carving out certain positions, responsibilities, and authorities from the Department of Administrative Services. This change involves a number of budgetary changes, establishment of a new fund, and revision of statutes for which the fiscal impact has not yet been determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means
