This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This bill would require updating or implementing new System Development Charge methodologies for all cities within the state. The statewide impact to comply with this legislation for cities is estimates at a one-time cost ranging between \$12.1 million to \$36.3 million. Additional legal fees, which are indeterminate at this time, are also anticipated to be incurred by cities and counties due to conflicts with current practices between fee assessment charges.
