Measure Description:

Establishes State Data Center Board and prescribes board's duties.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services (DAS)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting this measure from the House Committee on Consumer Protection and Government Efficiency to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The bill establishes the five-member State Data Center Board charged with determining policies for the State Data Center, including setting fees that the State Data Center charges other state agencies, and initiating pilot programs. The Board is required report annually to the legislature by January first of each year concerning the Board's and the State Data Center's activities. The Board is authorized to establish continuing or temporary advisory and technical committees to aid and advise the Board.

This bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Department of Administrative Services. The full impact of this bill is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
