WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Establishes Oregon Code of Military Justice governing state militia. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Relationship between the Oregon Code of Military Justice and the Uniform Code of Military Justice
- Provisions of measure

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Senate Bill 32 marks the completion of a transition that began in 2005, to organize state laws governing the military into a comprehensive body of regulatory code – the Oregon Code of Military Justice – aligned with the Uniform Code of Military Justice at the federal level.
