**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Expands authority of Oregon Health and Science University (OHSU) police department to have all the authority of a municipal police department. Requires creation of a complaint process. Authorizes mutual aid agreements with other police departments. Authorizes rulemaking. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

**MEASURE: SB 565 A**

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Topography of OHSU
- Response time
- Challenges of hospital environment

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** OHSU gained the authority to have a police department in the 2009 session but without the authority for officers to carry guns. Senate Bill 565 A removes the prohibition on guns and removes limitations on OHSU authority under ORS 353.050(16) and expands the authority to be similar to a city police department. A study of the challenges of the OHSU campus determined that officers should be armed or OHSU should hire armed guards. OHSU concluded arming officers was more cost effective.
