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Measure Description:

Specifies additional criteria for certifying health plans to participate in Oregon Health Insurance Exchange.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Oregon Health Insurance Exchange (ORHIX)

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting this measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the House Committee on Rules.

The bill specifies additional criteria for certifying health plans to participate in the Oregon Health Insurance Exchange.

This bill is anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Oregon Health Authority, the Oregon Health Insurance Exchange, and the Department of Consumer and Business Services.
