**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires certain information regarding notice of judicial foreclosure sale of residential property be published online and in newspaper of general circulation.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Oregon State Bar task force on legal notices
- Cost of posting notices of sale online and in newspaper
- Expectations of different individuals for availability of sale information

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Replaces the original measure.

**BACKGROUND:** Under existing statute, notices of sale on judicially foreclosed residential property are required to be published either on the Internet or in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where the property is located.

House Bill 2822 A requires that notices of sheriffs sales of judicially foreclosed residential property be published with certain information in the newspaper and that a complete notice of sale be published online.
