Measure Description:

Directs State Board of Education and State Board of Higher Education to work with Governor and conduct study on improving education governance.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Oregon University System (OUS), Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, Oregon Education Investment Board

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Higher Education and Workforce Development to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill increases the responsibility of the Higher Education Coordinating Council (HECC) in many areas. In the current biennium, HECC has no staff to perform these responsibilities and the Governor's budget proposes adding a limited number of staff for HECC. The HECC and potentially other agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
