WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires public universities and community colleges to charge in-state tuition for all honorably discharged veterans regardless of residency. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- No discussion; no Public Hearing in committee.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: University and community college students in Oregon pay lower tuition if they are residents and higher tuition if they are nonresidents. If those students are nonresident veterans, they pay less than other nonresidents but still more than residents. Under current law, a nonresident veteran undergraduate will pay resident rate plus half of the difference between resident and nonresident rates (ORS 352.375). Senate Bill 820 requires the same tuition for students who are veterans, regardless of residency, as for students who are residents.
