WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Authorizes State Medical Examiner to establish regions and assume responsibility for county medical examiner duties. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: County medical examiners are authorized to investigate and examine persons dying suddenly, unexpectedly, or from physical or chemical injury. The responsibility of the medical examiner is to determine cause and manner of death, and to document and preserve evidence. The concept of the State medical examiner providing county medical examiner services was proposed in the 2009 County Payments Study that analyzed options for counties that have had funding shortages.
