Measure Description:

Authorizes wholesale distribution of agricultural crops, produced on or off farm operator's property, that is integrated with farm use in one or more buildings that existed on or before May 19, 1970.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Counties, Department of Land Conservation and Development

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Land Use to the Committee on Rules. The bill authorizes wholesale distribution of raw or processed agricultural crops that is integrated with the farm use property that commenced on or before January 1, 2013 and is conducted in one or more buildings that existed on or before May 19, 1970. The agency or a local government may anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means
