Measure Description:

Directs Department of Education to provide technical expertise to assist schools, school districts and education service districts in complying with standards adopted by State Board of Education pertaining to student education records.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education, Education Service Districts (ESD), Local Education Agencies, School Districts

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis: This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill directs the Oregon Department of Education to provide technical assistance to schools and school districts with respect to complying with standard adopted by the State School board pertaining to student records. The agencies anticipate having a fiscal impact associated with this bill including the need for additional positions. The total amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
